### Code of Conduct

In order to provide an environment that is fun and safe for all participants and to ensure a more reverent experience, the leadership of the Youth Department have established the following expectations for the behavior of our students.

- Treat others with kindness and respect. Remember the Golden Rule! (Treat others as you want them to treat you. This is what the Law and the Prophets are all about. - Matthew 7:12)
- Treat your classrooms with respect. Don't forget to clean up and try to prevent messes from happening.
- Use only kind words. No fighting or arguing.
- The possession of drugs and/or weapons on Brookwood Baptist Church property and on any youth trip is strictly prohibited and will result in referral to appropriate Law Enforcement Authority.
- Please refrain from using cell phones during any lessons.
- Please be honest in your actions and words.
- Take responsibility for any actions that you do or do not make; understand the consequences of your actions.
- No loitering or wandering the hallways.

Should these rules not be observed, the following steps will be taken. Depending on the nature of the situation, the youth leadership may deem it necessary to start with a more appropriate step.

- 1) Verbal Warning from a Group Leader
- 2) Conference between Leaders and Student
- 3) Parents are contacted and notified of behavior
- 4) Parents are contacted and asked to make arrangements for the student to be sent home from the current activity.
